Council resolved, after discussion to:

c) Two members, on a rota basic, to staff it.

d) Suitable display material to be worked up. i) What council present does...it's purpose. ii) some form of survey.

e) Secy to write to organisations listed at Nov meeting to Copt Members (non voting)

Sustainable Cupar, ABC, Youth Cafe, Rotary, Bell Baxter.

f) That persons wishing to join the Council as Full Members be invited to be co-opted as non-voting Members, until next AGM. Then a process to fairly fill vacancies will be followed.

g) That meeting of Council will revert to Tuesday evenings forthwith.

Flooding

It was resolved that the council holds a public meeting to enable Fife council, and other organisations involved to explain the situation after the December flooding to residents.

(This had been announced by the Chair, with the support of Min Secy, at a Kinloss Park resident's meeting.)

Cllr Kennedy advised that the Leader of Fife Council, Cllr David Ross, was keen to attend, along with suitable experts. A provisional date of 26th Feb was possible, and the use of OPC would be rented. This may need to move back slightly.

The flooding at Hough park was also discussed. Worst seen. Questions on possibility the Fairground heavy vehicles etc, had damaged the drainage?

Cllr Kennedy stated that the emergency response from Fife council had been lacking, and that an internal review was ongoing.

(Note. Sustainable Cupar - River Eden Project has meeting on 12th Feb in Letham Village Hall which will also examine Flooding issues)
